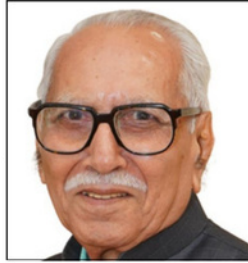

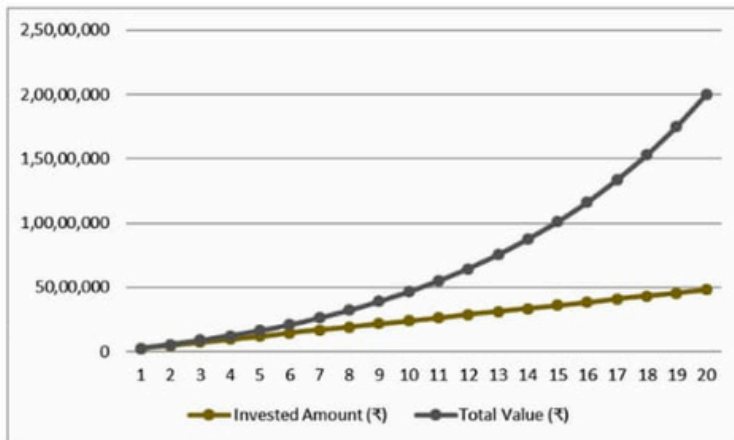

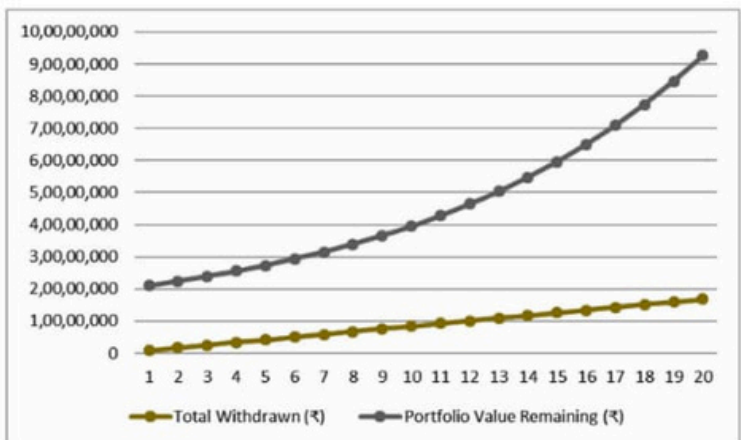

Dharma Charcha Series



Deepening Understanding of the 18 Paap Sthanak

Dharma Charcha Session 3 | 2nd December 2025

This unique partnership brings together global Jain scholars with the shared aim of exploring Jain philosophy through scientific reasoning and practical application.

The session was led by the renowned speaker, Dr. Bipin Doshi ji, who has guided this four-part series with depth and clarity. With around 90–92 participants joining live, the growing engagement reaffirmed the initiative's relevance and impact.

In this third session, Dr. Bipin Doshi ji delved deeply into the concept of Ahimsa (non-violence)—examining its scientific, logical, and ethical foundations within Jainism. He highlighted how violence manifests not only through physical actions but also through thoughts, intentions, and behaviors, emphasizing the importance of mental discipline and compassion. The session further addressed the role of education, professional responsibility, and societal regulations in curbing violence, while reinforcing Jain principles of charity, philanthropy, and unity through religion. Interactive discussions enriched the session, making it both reflective and intellectually stimulating.

With one more session remaining in the series, the Dharma Charcha continues to inspire deeper understanding, thoughtful dialogue.

JCAF Session 4 | 9th December 2025

This session brought together philosophical depth and practical wisdom, reinforcing the relevance of Jain principles in modern life.

Dr. Bipin Doshi ji emphasized the importance of applying Jain values to real-world challenges, particularly environmental concerns and the impact of human consumption on nature. He highlighted the distinction between truth and righteousness, explaining that while truth reflects honesty, righteousness demands morally justified action. The discussion drew attention to mindful living, noting that a large portion of material possessions are unnecessary and contribute to waste and environmental harm.

He further explained how the nature of violence has evolved, with modern lifestyles contributing more significantly than food-related causes. The concept of the four kasai was elaborated, categorizing passions into Raag and Raudra, and linking them to emotional and behavioral patterns. Stressing intent over activity, Dr. Doshi shared insights on confession, non-violence, non-attachment, and life-skill management.

The session concluded with thoughtful discussions on applied Jainism, leaving participants with practical takeaways to lead conscious, ethical, and balanced lives. The series as a whole stood as a landmark initiative for JCAF, blending spirituality with everyday decision-making.

JCAF South Mumbai Chapter | 13th December 2025

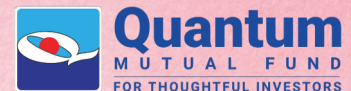
